

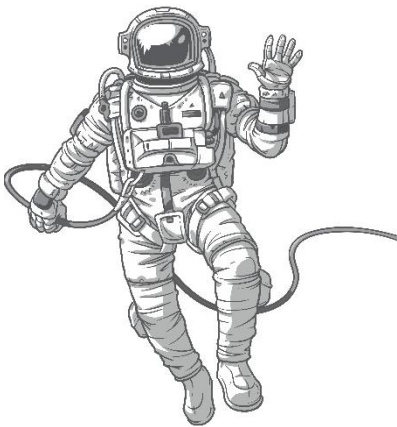

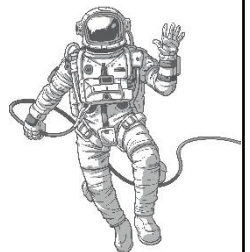

Now it's time to apply for the job! Look back at the skills that are requested on the wanted poster:

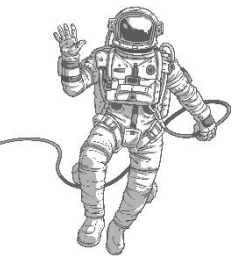
