

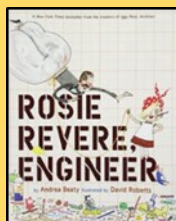
KS1 Hub Term 4 Curriculum Newsletter 2024

English



This term we will be reading 'The Street Beneath my Feet' and 'Rosie Revere Engineer.' In the story, Rosie visits the Tower Bridge exhibit and designs her own suspension. She sends off her own design for a competition but sadly she does not win. The children make

inferences about the character using the technique of thought tapping and then go on to write dictated letters of advice using a range of contracted verbs and spelling the common exception words could, should and would.



Bright Lights & Big Cities

RE

This term we will be listening to stories in the gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. The children will be thinking about the good news that Jesus brings through these stories. We will listen to the story of The Taxman, The Lepers and Jesus Feeds Five Thousand, recognising that Jesus gives instructions about how to behave.

Geography

We will be continuing our new topic of Bright Lights and Big Cities. We will be learning about the physical and human feature of London. We will then be using this knowledge to compare human and physical features with Kuala Lumpur. We will also be taking some time to learn about the Great Fire of London.

Maths

We follow the White Rose Maths. Year 1 children will be looking at place value of numbers to 50 before moving onto length and height and mass and volume. Year 2 children are starting the term with fractions and then moving onto time getting ourselves ready for SATs.

Science

This term we will be continuing to be looking at the topic of Seasonal Changes. The children will understand the differences of the four seasons and the weather in each. Then we will moving onto our topic 'Caring for the Planet'. We will be investigating why it is important to look after the planet and what we can do help.

Music

We will follow the Sing Up programme! In Year 1, the children will be completing 'The King in the castle'. In Year 2, the children will be completing 'Grandma Rap'. The children will be learning about pitch, rhythm and dynamics.

PSHE

We are learning through the Heart Smart programme and this term our theme is 'Don't hold on to What's Wrong'. Children will learn how to forgive and let go of bad feelings so we can feel happy again. They will learn that most friendships have ups and downs, and that these can often be worked through so that the friendship is repaired or even strengthened, and that resorting to violence is never right.

DT

The children will be designing a purposeful, functioning London taxi and exploring wheels and axles. The children will also be making transient art and pattern work using a range or combination of man-made and natural materials.

PE

This term we will be outside for our PE lessons so black track suit bottoms and black trainers will be needed. The children will be covering a range of skills and techniques in our Multi skills lessons. We will be developing children's agility and co-ordination by practising footwork and balance as they play a range of games.
