

Maths This term in Maths, we will be continuing to add and subtract. Our Year 3s will begin to explore more formal ways of adding and subtracting numbers, crossing tens and hundreds too. Year 4 will be adding and subtracting 4 digit numbers with 1 or more than 1 exchange. They will also be using estimating and checking strategies to build their confidence when solving problems. Later in the term, year 3 and 4 will move onto solving multiplication and division problems and applying their times table knowledge to their learning.	English In English this term we will be reading the two texts belows Odd and The Frost Giants by Neil Gaiman and The Polar Express. Odd and The Frost Giants is a text that links to our topic about the Vikings and we will be writing character and setting descriptions, as well as a recount from a different perspective. As we approach Christmas, we will be writing in role.	Religious Education In Religious Education this term we will be looking at the question 'What is the Trinity?' We will be looking at how the birth of Jesus was recorded in the different books of the bible and how these recounts link to the trinity. We will also be learning that Jesus, the son of God, is seen by Christians as revealing what God is like.	Science In Science this term, our topic is all about Sound. We will be linking our learning to the story below, 'Sounds All Around,' and we will be thinking about how we hear different sounds. We will be conducting experiments around the school, listening to loud and quiet, high and low noises and learning all about vibrations, reflections and absorption.	History In History this term, we will be continuing Invasions. We will be learning about the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor. We will begin to understand historical concepts such as continuity and change, cause and consequence, similarity, difference and significance, and use them to make connections, draw contrasts, analyse trends, frame historically valid questions and create their own structured accounts, including written narratives
P.S.H.E: Get Heartsmart! This term, we will be learning to let love in. We will be thinking about what the word love means, and times where we have felt loved or love towards someone. We will be thinking about how to speak the language of love or amor, even thinking about the word love in their own languages. As the term progresses, we will think about how great we are and how we need to remind ourselves of this.	Computing: In this unit, children will initially examine devices capable of recording digital audio, which will include identifying the input device (microphone) and output devices (speaker or headphones). Children will discuss the ownership of digital audio and the copyright implications of duplicating the work of others. In order to record audio themselves, children will use Audacity to produce a podcast, which will include editing their work, adding multiple tracks, and opening and saving the audio files. Finally, learners will evaluate their work and give feedback to their peers.	French Bonjour! In French this term, we will be learning all about 'Going To School'. We will be learning the vocabulary for words in and around school and the subjects that we are learning. Children will be exposed to a variety of activities through which they will be speaking, listening, reading and writing in French.	Design Technology In Design Technology we will be learning all about food packaging and how this can be used to help food last longer. We will also be making a healthy snack and designing packaging for the healthy snack.	P.E. In P.E. this term, we will be learning all about hockey. We will learn the skills of dribbling, passing, shooting and working as a team. We will discuss the importance of warming our bodies up and keeping healthy.
