

Maths: Year 3

In maths this term, we will be continuing our learning about multiplication and division. We will be learning how to multiply a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number and dividing a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number. The children will then learn about length and perimeter. Looking at the different units of measurements and moving onto measuring the perimeters of regular rectangles.

Science:

The children will be learning about sound this term. We will learn that all sounds are vibrations and that these travel through air, solids and liquids but the volume and pitch alters. We will investigate which areas of the school are the loudest and how we could use sound proofing to help protect our hearing.

English writing text 1

Cinnamon by Neil Gaiman

Children will explore the main character and how she overcomes adversity. We will be looking at friendship. They will be writing in role as the main character by writing diary entries and letters.



English writing text 2

The Baker by the Sea by Paula White

The children will use this book to explore what life was like in a remote fishing village in the past. They will create travel brochures to encourage people to visit the village after it has been rebuilt.



Maths: Year 4 will be learning about factor pairs and multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100. The children will also learn about length and perimeter, including finding the perimeter of polygons and calculating the perimeter.



LKS2 Term 3

Winding River

PE:

This term the children will be focusing their studies on Gymnastics. They will need their black shorts and house t-shirts and will be working barefoot in the hall. They will develop their understanding of individual and paired work, developing their balancing, cannon and bridge work.

Geography:

In Geography we will be focussing on rivers. Children will classify, compare and contrast different types of geographical features. Children will be introduced to different parts of a river. They will use illustrations and information to help develop their awareness of how each part of the river is formed and how it flows. The children will also be identify where significant rivers around the world are located on a map

Art:

Our Art focus for term 3 is on still life with an artist focus on Paul Cezanne. We will look at composition, tone and texture and how these can be reflected in our work through our sketching and our painting. We will use Cezanne's art work as inspiration for our own still life compositions



Spanish:

In Spanish this term, we will be learning all about our families and the members of the family.

Music:

The children will be learning to sing and play a song. They will also be learning about chords and develop skills on tuned percussion. The children will be learning to listen and compare different ways of playing the same song on different instruments.

Computing:

This unit explores the concept of sequencing in programming through Scratch. It begins with an introduction to the programming environment, which will be new to most learners. They will be introduced to a selection of motion, sound, and event blocks which they will use to create their own programs, featuring sequences. The final project is to make a representation of a piano.
