
UKS2 Term 4 Curriculum Newsletter



<u>English</u>



In English this term, we will be focussing on the genre of writing Recount texts and in particular biographies. We will be learning about the astronaut Chris Hadfield by reading his book The Darkest Dark and building up our skills to write a biography about his life.

<u>Maths</u>

In maths this term, Year 5 and 6 will be revisiting fractions but also making links with decimals and percentages. Year 5 children will be learning about thousandths as decimals and fractions and will be ordering and comparing decimals to 2 decimal points. They will then move onto learning about percentages as decimals and fractions.

In Year 6, they will be understanding fractions as division and then move onto understanding percentages and fractions as percentages. They will be finding percentages of amounts in both single and multi-step problems and using percentages for missing

Religious Education

Big Question: I wonder what can be done to reduce racism? Can religion help?

This investigation enables pupils to learn in depth from different religious and spiritual ways of life through exploring ideas and examples of what religions do to reduce racism, including for example the work of different religious leaders in promoting respect and the teaching of different sacred texts about human unity. The unit implements the principal aim of RE, which is to engage pupils in systematic enquiry into significant human questions which religion and worldviews address, so that they can develop the understanding and skills needed to appreciate and appraise varied responses to these questions, as well as develop responses of their

We will learn that light travels in straight lines from a light source but it can change direction if reflected. We will explore the idea of how shadows are formed and revisit the terms translucent, transparent and opaque. We will end the term by planning and conducting a

Don't Hold on to what's Wrong!


