This week's learning

It has been simply fabulous to welcome back our school community this week and we have been very busy in Upper Key Stage 2.

We are taking part in a whole school transition project based on the book Here We Are: Notes for Living on Planet Earth by



Oliver Jeffers. We have looked at where Earth fits in our Solar system, and shared ideas about how we were feeling about being back here together in this shared space.

We have written poems about our favourite places and written letters to special people. We have also written to our school governors and local MPs

with suggestions for how to keep our local environment clean and green!

In Maths we have been sorting, grouping and counting objects and numbers in different ways, explaining our reasons for how we sorted them.
