This week's learning

This week we have continued with the book Here I Am by Oliver Jeffers. AS a hub e have been exploring the text in different ways, lead by pupil opinions, discussions and experiences through lockdown. As a result, we have explored expressive and descriptive language through prose and writing



poetry about life on our planet and how we feel. We have also been exploring personal opinions and descriptive diaries having a go at writing from other characters points of view. Each class has produced work for display.

In maths we have been exploring place value with whole numbers up to 10 million.

In Art we have explored the element of Fire by Joachim Beuckelaer and produced different modern day interpretations of it using drawings, paintings and photography.

In PE we have been exploring outdoor and adventurous team games. And developing our cooperation, communication and problem solving skills.
