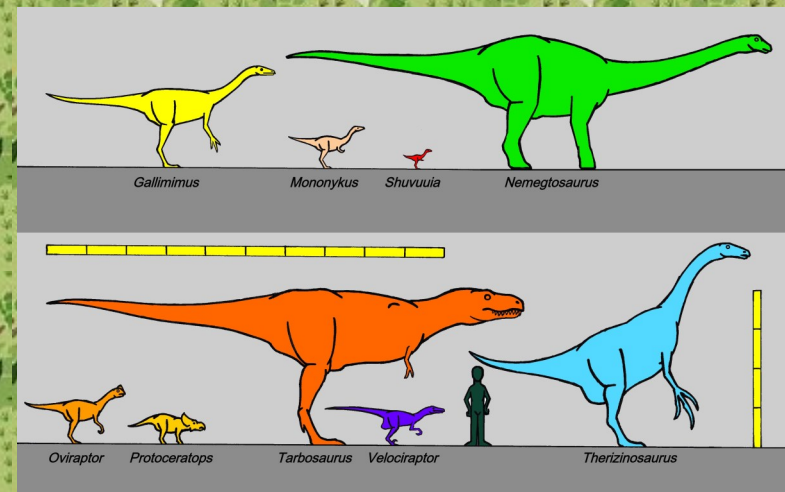
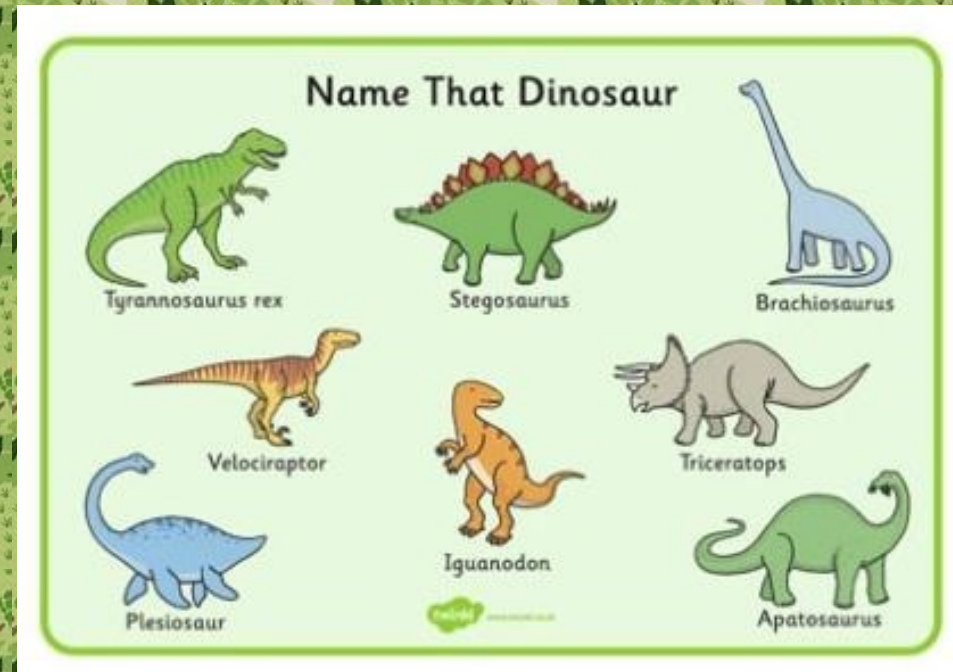


EYFS Dinosaur Knowledge Grid

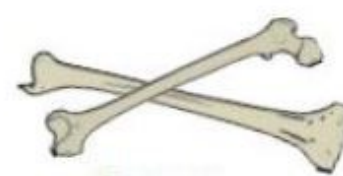
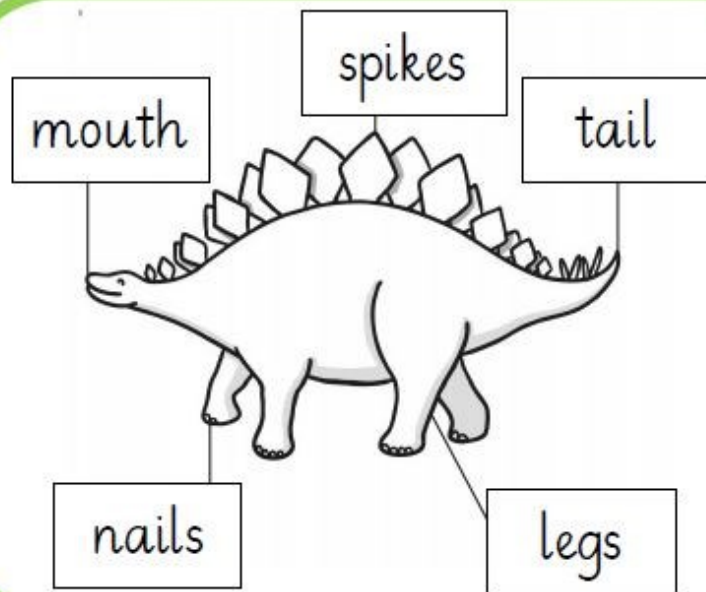
Dinosaurs lived millions of years ago. It is important to know that dinosaurs and humans did not share the Earth.

Dinosaur Facts:

- ◇ Some dinosaurs were big and some dinosaurs were small.
- ◇ Most dinosaurs were plant eaters, like the Diplodocus, and some dinosaurs were meat eaters like the Tyrannosaurus Rex.
- ◇ Some dinosaurs walked on two legs and some walked on four.
- ◇ Some dinosaurs had horns, crests and spikes to help defend themselves.



Term	Definition
Dinosaur	A group of reptiles that lived for over 160 million years.
Extinct	When a species of animals or plants die out or disappear completely.
Fossil	The remains of a prehistoric plant or animal embedded and preserved in rock.
Herbivore	An animal that eats plants.
Carnivore	An animal that eats other animals.

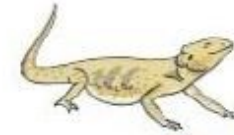
