



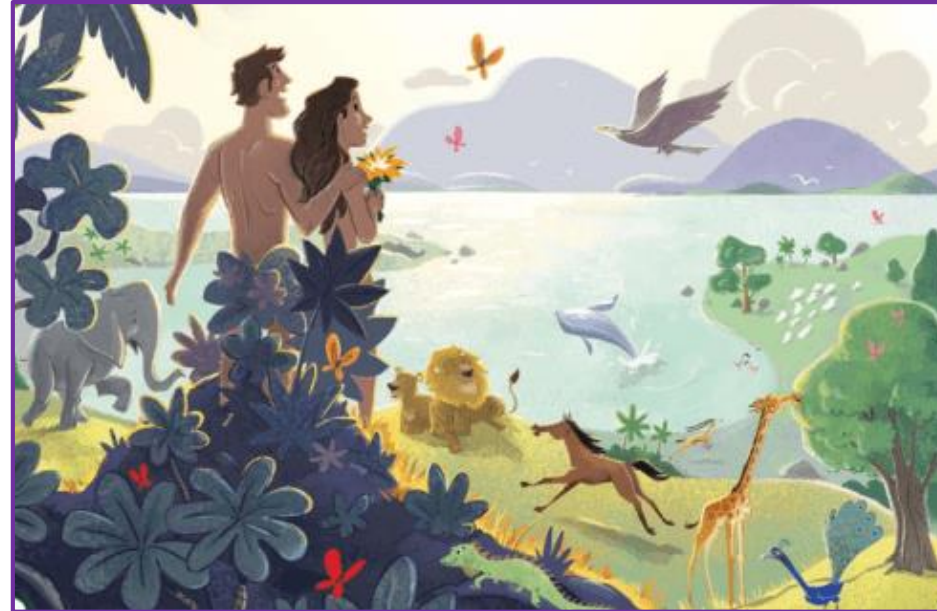

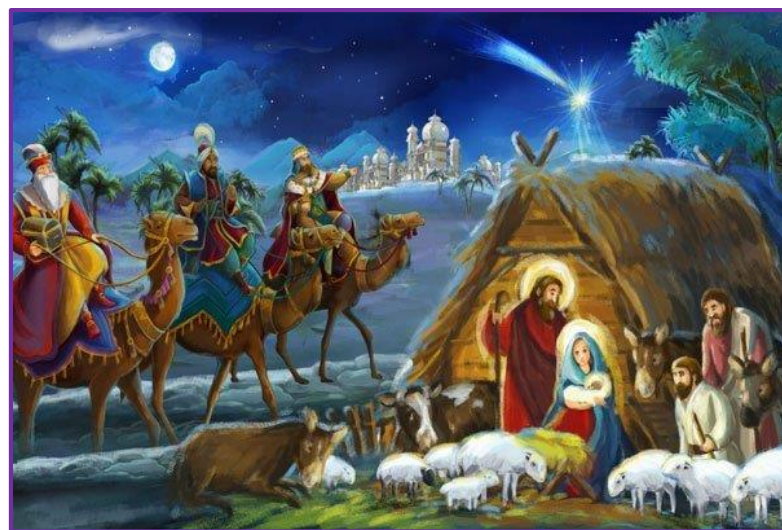
Why do Christians Perform Nativity plays at Christmas?

God's messengers are called Prophets

Jewish people know that they get things wrong but they can say sorry to God and God forgives them.



God made the world but people kept doing things wrong! Jonah had a message from God to tell the people that they were doing the wrong thing but instead Jonah did the wrong thing too!
