to fly towards asteroids...*



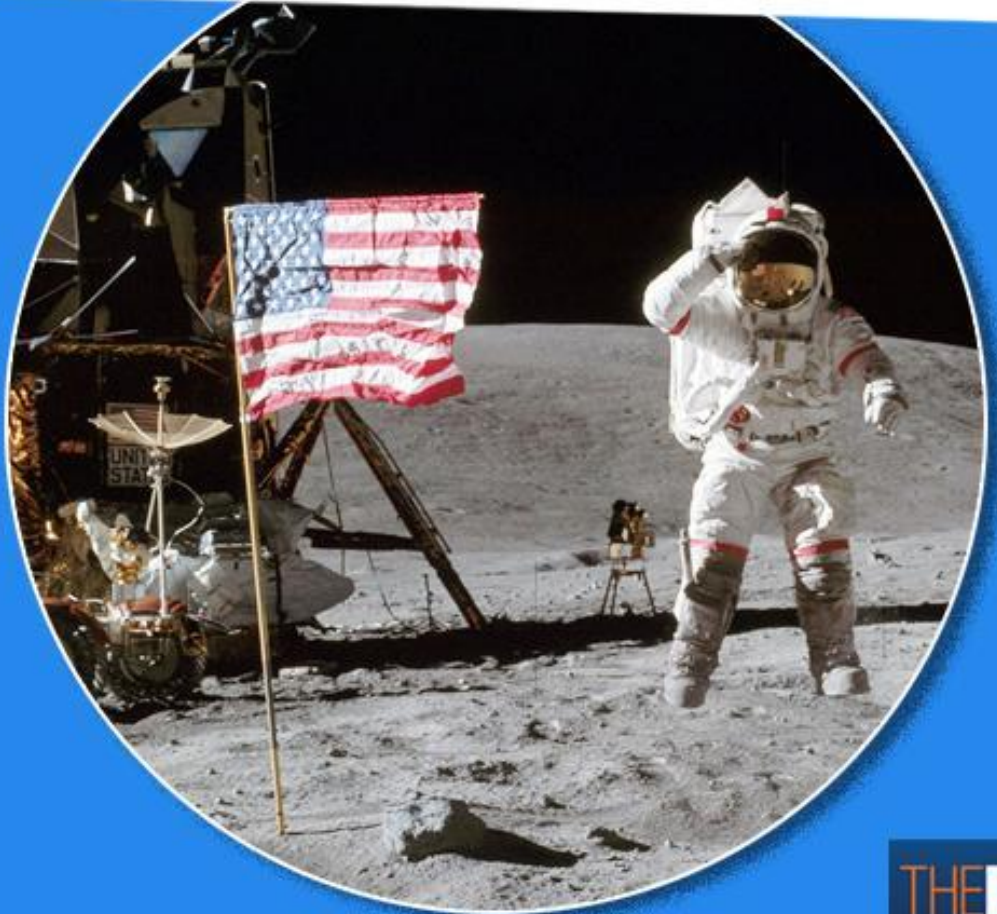
*...and nudge them so that
