It's in Asia

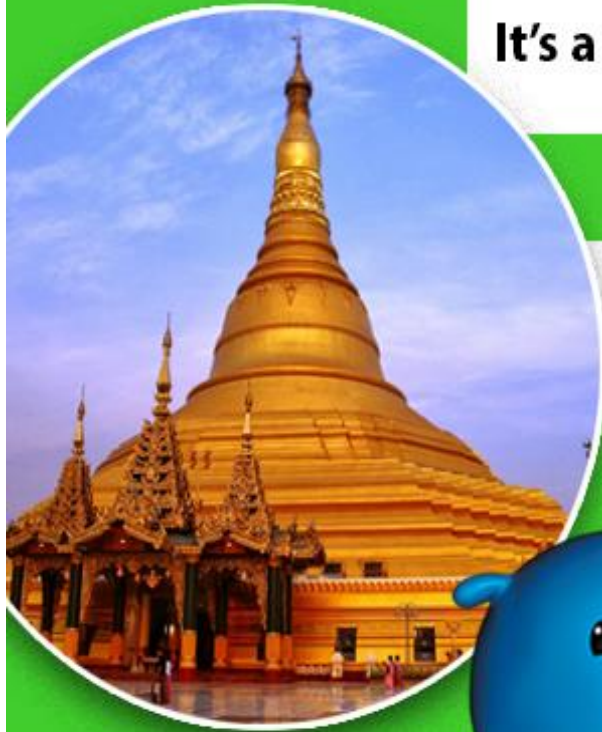


It is Myanmar!
