	chunks can help us to achieve them, small gains can add up to large improvements).

2 mins	Slide 6: Share and discuss the key questions on the slide. Finish the discussion by identifying		
	that they used the marginal gains theory to help them improve.		
	Slide 7: Display the quote from the book about 'marginal gains'.		
2 mins	Slide 8: Ask pupils to explain the theory to a partner. Draw a pictorial representation of the		
	theory on the worksheet (for example a jigsaw, brick wall etc).		
3 mins	Slide 9: Pupils to apply the theory to their school day. Identify what they could do to gain back		
	10 minutes a day to dedicate to learning a new or challenging skill. Record on worksheet.		
2 mins	Slide 10: Explain that the the	Slide 10: Explain that the theory only works if you are clear about your current position and	
	where you want to get to. Ask pupils to outline where they currently are in relation to the goal		
	they set at the beginning of the course and where they want to get to.		
4 mins	Slide 11: Give pupils time to complete their own marginal gains plan.
