







He sees his father sleeping

He sees the shadows moving On the bedroom wall And the sun at the window And his teddy And his ball.











To be dried.










And catch fishes in.











And his ball.










He sees his grandma ironing His father pouring tea His other sister squabbling She wants him on *her* knee.



He sees his mother dozing In the easy chair And a dog in the doorway Who shouldn't be there.










He sees his nightie warming On the oven door His sisters in the clothes-horse Puddles on the floor.








He sees the landing mirror With its rainbow rim And a mother with a baby Just like him.
