
## STATISMENTS

There are 4 main types of sentence.




Statements are sentences which tell you something. They end with a full stop.

They are the largest cat species, with a body length of up to 3.3 metres.


## OUISITONS

There are 4 main types of sentence.




Questions are sentences which ask you something. They end with a question mark.

What is your favourite animal?



## COMMANDS

There are 4 main types of sentence.



Commands are sentences which tell you what to do.

An urgent or angry command can have an exclamation mark. They can be very short

sentences (sometimes as short as one word).

Don't do that!


Stop.

## EXCLAMATIONS

There are 4 main types of sentence.



Exclamations are sentences which say something with anger, urgency, surprise or amusement.

They always end with an exclamation mark.

I can't believe it!

I saw that!

Oh no!

How wonderful!
