## **Holy Book**

## **Guru Granth Sahib**

The Sikh holy book includes writing by the Gurus, except the 6th, 7th and 8th Gurus. It is not known why they did not contribute their own writings, although the 8th Guru – Guru Harkrishan was very young when he became the Guru and died young too from smallpox, so would not have had the opportunity to do so.

Guru Arjan identified the need to collate the religious writings of the previous Gurus to ensure that only authentic texts were being used by Sikhs.
