This week's learning

It has been great seeing lots of smiley faces this week; the children are very happy to be back and are keen to get on with their learning.

We are taking part in a whole school transition project based on the book Here We Are: Notes for Living on



Planet Earth by Oliver Jeffers. We have looked at where Earth fits in our Solar system, visited other countries on Google Earth and talked about places in this world. We have labelled continents, oceans and countries and have looked at where our families live and countries we would like to visit.

We have written about our favourite place in the world and why it is so important to us. We have also thought about and written to a special person or pet in our lives and explained why they are so amazing to us.

In Maths we have been remembering our 2,3,5 and 10 times table and having been counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. Today we looked at 2, 3 and 4 digit numbers and worked out which number is less than or greater than.
