


# LOWER Key Stage 2 News

We have had a creative week of learning this week. The children had a no pens day on Wednesday where they did not write all day and created lilies to go on our whole school display about flourishing.



In English the children compared their house with Gregory's parents house and wrote instructions how to build a model house and then started building their models. Then the children wrote in role as Gregory and sent a letter home to his mum or dad and described what he was doing and how he
