This week's learning

We have had a lovely second whole week being back in school. We have continued with the school book Here We Are: by Oliver Jeffers. We have written about what we would like to be in the future, what job we would like to do. The children have thought about why they would like this job and what they may do in this role.



In Maths we have continued with place value. Year 3 have looked at Hundreds, Tens and Ones using dienes apparatus and place value counters. Year 4 have looked at Thousands as well as Hundreds, Tens and Ones and how a number can be represented in different ways i.e.

4723 as 4 thousand, 7 hundred, 2 tens and 3 ones and also 3 thousand, 17 hundreds, 2 tens and 3 ones.


In RE we will continued to think about the special gifts that God has given us and what makes them special in the way that we can help others.
