


LOWER Key Stage 2 News

This week's learning

We have been learning outside this week and the children have thoroughly enjoyed their Autumn Walk collecting leaves and objects. Then the children thought of words to describe their leaves and objects e.g. deep



red leaf changing colour. This was then turned into an Autumn poem. We have continued with our book Gregory's Cool and have written some character descriptions about Gregory and Lennox.


In Maths the children have been rounding to the nearest 10 and 100. In

RE we have looked at the story of Jonah and the Whale again and the children remembered a lot of key facts from last week. This week the children have created their own comic strip version of the story.

In History we have started thinking about what the children already know about Egyptians from looking at the Egyptian timeline. Then the children wrote questions about what they want to find out about The Egyptians. We used a technic called KWL - K what you think you know, W –what do you want to know and L-what have you learnt already. In Art the children have created line drawings of a Pharaoh's mask.
