If I add the number of lorries and bikes together then it will be equal to the number of cars

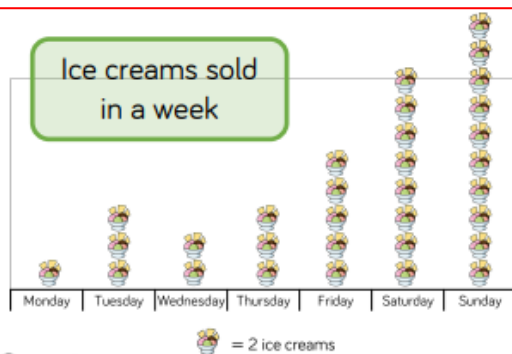
Is he right? Convince me.
