KS1 TERM 3 2025/2026

ENGLISH

This term we will be continuing to help Professor Klunk and the Faithful Friends on their Curious Quest. The children will think about suggestions to help the Faithful Friends overcome the challenges they face to continue with the quest. The children's writing will be sent back to Professor Klunk through the portal. The children will be continuing to practise forming sentences using a capital letter and a full stop.

MATHS

This term, we will be focusing on the topics of geometry, place value, addition and subtraction, money and multiplication and division. The children will begin to understand the difference between tens and ones, the differences between notes and coins and the values of each and also how we use arrays to help with multiplication and division facts when counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

ART

This term we will focus on the artist Pablo Picasso and his style of art exploring the concept of cubism. The children create their own cubist-inspired artwork using simple shapes and colours.

MUSIC

This term we will be looking at a unit called football it is a lively, rhythmic chant about football. This unit sees children echo singing, composing word patterns, improvising with mi-re-do, and playing a percussion ostinato. We will explore the difference between pitched patterns and rhythm patterns, higher and lower.

SCIENCE

In this unit we will learn how to identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will identify the different features. The children will also be encouraged to recognise the similarities and differences between the different groups.

GEOGRAPHY

This term we will focus on the difference between hot and cold countries. The children will learn all about identifying hot and cold places, locating hot and cold places, features of a hot or cold place, how animals adapt to a hot or cold place and how to pack for a hot or cold holiday.

PE

Our Outdoor focus is ball skills using our feet. Our Indoor focus is dance, children will respond to rhythm and patterns through their movement.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Our focus this term is 'What is good news?' We will be looking at stories from the four gospels, what the gospels are and how good news brings peace. We will also be considering why Christians pray.
