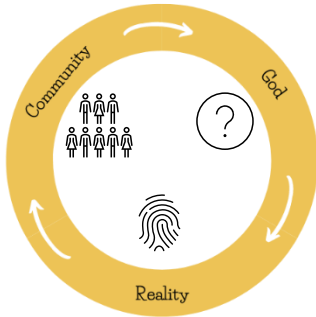




What is it like to follow God?


What do people think and believe about God?

Key Vocabulary	
Old Testament 	The Old Testament is the first part of the Bible that tells stories about God, people, and how the world began.
Commandment 	A commandment is a rule that tells us what we should do. In the Bible, God gave people commandments to help them know how to live and be kind.
Promise 	A promise is when you say you will do something and you really mean it.
Covenant 	A covenant is a special promise between two people or between God and people. In the Bible, God made a covenant with Noah and promised never to flood the whole earth again.
Follow 	Follow means to go after someone, go the same way as them or do what they ask. Christians try to follow God's way and do what he tells them to do.

Key Knowledge
The Old Testament tells the story of a particular group of people, the children of Israel known as the People of God – and their relationship with God.
The People of God try to live in the way God wants, following his commands and worshipping him.
They believe he promises to stay with them and Bible stories show how God keeps his promises.
