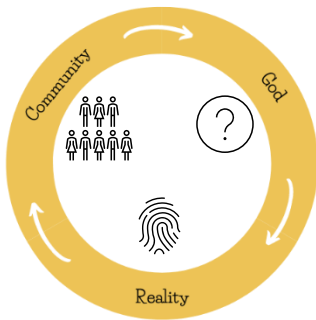





## Year 2 - Term 1 - Creation

Key Vocabulary	
<b>Old Testament</b> 	Genesis is the very first book in the Bible and the Torah. It tells the Christian and Jewish story of how God made the world. Genesis means 'beginning' - it's all about how everything started.
<b>Creation</b> 	Creation means making something.
<b>Creator</b> 	A creator is someone who makes something.
<b>Sustainer</b> 	A sustainer is someone who keeps things going or takes care of them.
<b>Harvest</b> 	Harvest time is when farmers collect the fruits, vegetables, and crops that have grown in the fields. At Harvest Festival, many Christians say thank you to God for all that they have.

Key Knowledge
The Old Testament tells the story of a particular group of people, the children of Israel known as the People of God — and their relationship with God.
The People of God try to live in the way God wants, following his commands and worshipping him.
They believe he promises to stay with them and Bible stories show how God keeps his promises.
