Key Vocabulary	
<b>Gospel</b> 	Gospel means 'good news'. Christian people believe Jesus brings good news for all people. For many Christians, this good news is being loved by God and being forgiven for bad things.
<b>Justice</b> <b>Social Justice</b> 	Justice means making sure people are treated fairly. It's about doing the right thing, helping when something is wrong, and making sure everyone has what they need to live safely and happily.
<b>Responsibility</b> 	Responsibility means looking after something or doing what you are meant to do.
<b>Kingdom of God</b> 	The Kingdom of God means a world aligned with God's values, such as mercy, compassion and humility.
<b>Fairness</b> 	Fairness means treating people equally in a way that is right and makes sure everyone has what they need.
<b>Inclusion</b> 	Inclusion means making sure everyone feels welcome and is able to join in.

Key Knowledge
Many Christians believe Jesus challenges everyone about how to live — he sets the example for loving God and your neighbour, putting others first.
Many Christian people believe Jesus shows love and forgiveness to unlikely people.
Many Christians try to be like Jesus — they want to know him better and better.
Many Christians try to put his teaching and example into practice in lots of ways, from church worship to social justice.
